

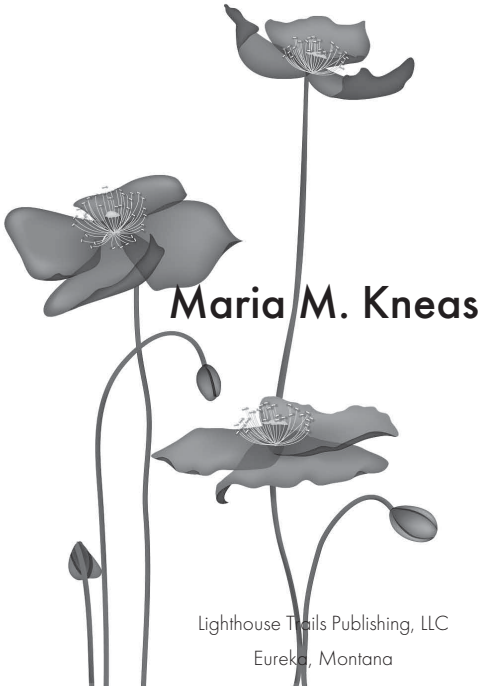



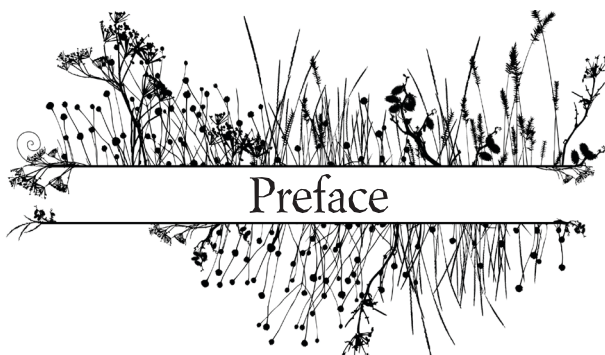
And we know that
